

Blue Margarita

Silver tequila
Blue Curaçao to color (1/3 to 1/2 the amount of the tequila)
Fill up with regular old tequila mixer
Slice of lime

Paradise Sunrise

Vodka to taste and tolerance
Squeeze 1/4 of a lime, drop in the segment
Dollop of grenadine for color
Fill up approx. 1/3 of the glass volume with passion fruit juice (we use Rubicon brand)
Fill up remaining space in the glass (leave room for ice) with San Pellegrino lemon

Long Island Tea

1 oz. vodka
1 oz. gin (London dry gin)
1 oz. light rum
1 oz. tequila
1 oz. lemon juice
1 oz. Gran Gala orange liqueur (or triple sec, or Grand Marnier, or similar)
1 tsp sugar (recipe specifies “superfine sugar”)
3 oz. Coke

Hemingway Daiquiri

Ice
2 ounces white rum
3/4 ounce fresh lime juice
1/2 ounce fresh grapefruit juice
1/2 ounce maraschino liqueur
1 lime wheel, for garnish (optional)

Fill a cocktail shaker with ice. Add all of the remaining ingredients except the lime wheel and shake well. Strain into a chilled coupe and garnish with the lime wheel.

Rum Runner

1 oz. light rum
1 oz. dark rum
1 oz. banana liqueur
1 oz. blackberry liqueur
1 oz. orange juice
1 oz. pineapple juice
Splash of Grenadine (color)
Garnish with fruit

Sazerac

Ice cubes
1 sugar cube or 1 teaspoon sugar
1/4 teaspoon Peychaud's bitters
1/8 teaspoon angostura bitters
1 teaspoon water
1/4 cup rye whiskey (such as Michter's)
2 teaspoons absinthe (such as Pernod's)
1 lemon peel twist
